

**Building Trust** 

*"And those who know your name put their trust in you, for you, O LORD, have not forsaken those who seek you."* Psalm 9:10

"Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths." Proverbs 3:5-6

"The LORD is my strength and my shield; in him my heart trusts, and I am helped; my heart exults, and with my song I give thanks to him." Psalm 28:7

Many of us know or realize that the scriptures often speak of how we ought to trust in the Lord, even with all our hearts and with all our might. He even promises that He has already gone before us. With these encouraging

words let us be a people who are willing to build Trust in the one who is worthy of Trust. Let us be a people that believe that as we Trust in Him and seek His face, His wisdom, and His presence, we are assured He will lead us according to His will and good purposes. Today, sit with the Lord, take a slow deep breath, and ask the Lord to lead you, with His grace, to release to Him whatever may be worrying you most. Trust in Him, that He knows exactly what He is doing! Allow the Lord to help you build trust one prayer, one moment, and one breath at a time.
