Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting and praying. Christians make a cross on their foreheads because they feel shame and guilt about their sins. People help the poor and needy by providing essential things like clothing and food. We make the sign of the cross on our foreheads to remind us of our sinful nature and God's forgiveness. It marks the start of Lent, the 40 Days of penitence.



Director Dallas Jenkins's new original series, *The Chosen,* is revolutionary. It offers viewers a glimpse into what the daily and extraordinary life of Jesus Christ and his disciples might have looked like 2,000 years ago and invites the viewer into His story. As a producer myself, I've seen the power film can have to promote the Lamb's agenda of love, truth and justice. *The Chosen* does that in an incredibly compelling way." (*A recommendation by Pastor Samuel Rodriguez*)

I am quite impressed with the close read of Scripture and the brilliant casting and acting. It is amazing to realize that this project, which will be 7 seasons in all, is completely volunteer-funded. It is not available on Netflix or anything else, just the app. An occupational hazard for most pastors is the notice all the variances in whether the producers stray from the accuracy of Scripture, but this series (only 1 and 2 seasons are available now but season 3 is now fully funded and will be soon). Season 4 will film in 2023.

I found myself taking notes! Seriously, I have rarely been positive about these kinds of films yet this one is unique in so many ways. This series does not follow any denominational doctrine, but just sticks close to the Word. I especially like how it embellishes the story with very believable interpretation of the daily life of these characters.

So, perhaps as a Lenten practice you could download this app and see for yourselves how very cool *The Chosen* is. Remember, it's free! Every pastor I know who has watched it LOVED it! That is high praise coming from that group!
