

- 1 lb Cooked Spaghetti
- 2 Tbs Margarine
- 3 Eggs
- 1 cup+ Parmesan Cheese
- 24 oz Cottage Cheese
- 32 oz Spaghetti sauce (Ragu,Thick & Zesty)
- 1 lb Ground beef, browned
- Preheat oven 325 degrees
- **Spray two 9X13 pans with cooking spray

- Combine cooked spaghetti, margarine, eggs & parmesan cheese and spread in pans
- Add cottage cheese layer on top
- Mix sauce and browned ground beef and spread on top
- Sprinkle with more parmesan cheese on top
- Bake 30 minutes.
- **Note: Recipe makes two pans. You could make only half of recipe...OR make full recipe and cover one with aluminum foil before baking, place in freezer. Then I have another meal ready to cook and have at another time!
